<b>Art</b>

## General Uniform Information

### Jewellery

A watch and one earring in each lobe are permitted. Years 11 – 13 earrings may be the smallest gold, silver or pearl stud only.

### Hair

Longer than the collar must be neatly tied back and kept off the face using plain black, brown or navy blue bands and same coloured accessories.

Ribbons may be red, white or navy 2-3 cm wide.

Headbands (narrow) may be black, brown or navy only.

### Bags

Bags should be plain blue or black.

## Uniform Shop

The Old Girls' League runs the Uniform Shop and is the exclusive stockist of the Diocesan School Uniform. The shop is situated in the School grounds next to the Sports Centre.

If you wish to order special sizes please do so early enough to ensure the uniform is available by the beginning of the School year.

The Uniform Shop sells both new and second hand Diocesan Uniform. If you wish to purchase second hand uniform items, please be aware that supplies can fluctuate daily. Summer uniform is to be worn in Terms 1 and 4 and winter uniform in Terms 2 and 3. A changeover period, during which time either uniform may be worn will be advertised on the School website.
