- Continuation of all scholarships is subject to meeting the criteria of the scholarship each year. Scholarships are reviewed annually in October by our Senior Management Team. As well as the criteria outlined above, students are expected to show exemplary behaviour, good academic performance and participation in the overall life of the School.
- Scholarships are available to New Zealand citizens and permanent residents only. Students must have attended a New Zealand school for at least three years.
- Your scholarship application needs to be accompanied by a <u>Diocesan School for Girls application form</u>. This form is available on our website or by clicking above. Please type next to your daughter's surname 'scholarship'.
- There is a \$300 non-refundable registration fee for scholarship applications, to be paid when you submit your school application.
- Should the student be successful in attaining a scholarship, the student's family is
 responsible for the registration fee, enrolment fee, the remainder of the tuition fees, as
 well as all incidental costs including, but not limited to; laptop, school trips, uniforms and
 stationery.
- Diocesan has a policy of awarding one scholarship per student, so if you are awarded a sports scholarship you are not eligible for other scholarships.
