Due to the high demand for places not all applicants will be selected for an interview. The Director of Admissions and Head of Senior and Junior Schools review every application following the closing date.

The following criteria are taken into consideration in our selection process.

What are we looking for?

- Affiliation to Diocesan through current or past siblings
- Daughters or Granddaughters of Diocesan Alumnae.
- Students who have a family link eg Aunt, cousin
- Daughters of Anglican Clergy
- Students with a positive attitude and a passion for learning
- Students with excellent school reports; both in academic achievement and key competencies
- Co-curricular involvement in sports and arts
- Proficiency in the English Language
- Boarders

No one factor by itself is a determining factor. We are looking for students who will be a great fit for Dio and our values, who will make the most of the opportunities available and who will also contribute to our school community.
